#### Norman R. Bobins Professor of Economics, University of Chicago

Randall S. Kroszner served as a Governor of the Federal Reserve System from March 2006 until January 2009. During his time as a member of the Federal Reserve Board, he chaired the committee on Supervision and Regulation of Banking Institutions and the committee on Consumer and Community Affairs. He served for George W. Bush as Economic Adviser on the President's Council of Economic Advisers (CEA), and is a frequent guest on CNBC.
